TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

Players are advised to retain this part of the entry form for their own information, noting the entry conditions.

Age Eligibility: Entrants in junior events must supply their birth dates and produce their birth certificates if requested. Eligibility for junior events is based on the player's age as at 30th September, 2010

Withdrawals: Players who withdraw from an event on or after 12 September, 2010, or withdraw from an event during the tournament, will be penalised under the TA and MA Events Disciplinary Policy, except in those cases where a medical certificate or other reasonable cause is provided for non-participation. Withdrawal notification must be in writing and submitted to the tournament director immediately. Evidence in support of the withdrawal (ie. medical certificate etc) must be submitted to the tournament director within seven days of the withdrawal notification

Entries: No player shall be permitted to enter in more than two events and these must be in the same age group.

Matches: All Singles Events shall be played using the elimination format with compulsory feed-in and all matches in main draw shall be the best-of-three sets. In any set, if the score reaches six games all, a tiebreak shall be played to determine the winner of the set.

Doubles: All doubles events shall be played using the knockout format. In any set, if the score reaches six games all, a tiebreak shall be played to determine the winner of the set. If the score reaches one set all, the deciding third set shall be replaced by a match tie-breaker (first to 10 points)

A player entering a doubles event without naming a partner shall accept the partner allocated by the committee, but this does not impose any obligation on the committee to find a partner.

Consolation/Feed-in Championship: All singles events FIC will be played for losers in the main draw up to an including the round of 16. In FIC matches, if the score reaches one set all, the deciding third set shall be replaced by one match tiebreak game. A play-off for top 8 positions will also be conducted.

Surface: Drinan Park has 11 Claycourts, Rotary Park 7 Synthetic Grasscourts. Also some outside courts will be used and some of these courts are Hardcourts.

Exemptions: Players must be available at all times during the tournament. No time exemptions will be granted.

Entry Fees: Singles \$44, Doubles \$22each

Balls: Slazenger Hardcourt

TOURNAMENT RULES AND POLICIES

This tournament will be conducted in accordance with Tennis Australia's Member Protection By-law, these rules and regulations and the Tennis Australia's Events Disciplinary Policy (each as amended from time to time).

1. I acknowledge that as a participant in a Tennis Australia sanctioned event I agree to comply with the ITF Rules of Play, the Tennis Australia Events Disciplinary Policy (including its reference to spectator behaviour and interference), the Tennis Australia Member Protection By-Law and the Tennis Australia Anti-Doping Policy.
2. Inappropriate spectator behaviour could result in denial of entry at future Tennis Australia and Member Association sanctioned events, and will be dealt with in accordance with the above policies. This includes, but is not limited to, behaviour at tennis venues, hotels and transport vehicles.
3. In consideration of accepting my entry into the tournament, I grant and assign to Tennis Australia and the host club/centre/association and any third party at the reasonable discretion of Tennis Australia the right in perpetuity throughout the world to make, use, show and reproduce at their discretion, motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television, sound recordings and any other reproductions of any description of me taken or produced during or in connection with the tournament. I agree that my name, voice, likeness, image and biographical material may also be used and reproduced in any way for the purpose of providing information and news in relation to the tournament, audio visual coverage, distribution and broadcast of the tournament, archival purposes, and publicising, promoting and advertising Tennis Australia and the tournament. I acknowledge that this usage, including for commercial purposes, is without compensation or notice to myself, heirs, devisees, executors, administrators or assigns.
