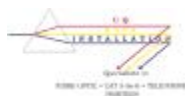

TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

Players are advised to retain this part of the entry form for their own information, noting the entry conditions.

1. **Age Eligibility:** Entrants in junior events must supply their birth dates and produce their birth certificates if requested. Eligibility for junior events is based on the player's age as at 30th September, 2010.
2. **Withdrawals:** Players who withdraw from an event on or after 9th September, 2010, or withdraw from an event during the tournament, will be penalised under the Tennis Australia Code of Behaviour, except in those cases where a medical certificate or other reasonable cause is provided for non-participation. Withdrawal notification must be in writing and submitted to the tournament director immediately. Evidence in support of the withdrawal (i.e. medical certificate etc) must be submitted to the tournament director within seven days of the withdrawal notification
3. **Entries:** No player shall be permitted to enter in more than two events; and if entered in two events these events must be in the same age group
4. **Matches:** All Singles Events shall be played using the continuous play format with built in feed-in and all matches in main draw shall be the best-of-three sets. In any set, if the score reaches six games all, a tiebreak shall be played to determine the winner of the set.
5. **Doubles:** All doubles events shall be played using the knockout format. In any set, if the score reaches six games all, a tiebreak shall be played to determine the winner of the set. If the score reaches one set all, the deciding third set shall be replaced by a match tie-breaker (first to 10 points). **No Mixed Doubles in 2010.** A player entering a doubles event without naming a partner shall accept the partner allocated by the committee, but this does not impose any obligation on the committee to find a partner.
6. **Consolation/Feed-in Championship:** A mandatory FIC will be played in all singles events for losers in the main draw up to an including losing Round of 16. There will also be play-offs to determine the top 8 positions. In FIC matches, if the score reaches one set all, the deciding third set shall be replaced by one match tiebreak (first to 10 points).
7. **Continuous Feed-in Draws will be used.** This event is part of the entire draw system which will provide tennis for all competitors by using the continuous play draws (Approved by Tennis Australia). This will ensure all players receive a similar amount of matches whether they finish first or last. These matches will be played first to 9 games with a tiebreaker at 8 games all. Players who nominate in the draw must be prepared to play matches every day during the event unless a valid medical certificate is produced. If you are not prepared to play every day please don't enter this tournament.
8. **Surface:** 24 Hardcourts will be used at Victoria Park Regional Tennis Centre, Rockhampton for age groups 14/u-16/u-18/u. 11 Hardcourts & 4 Synthetic Grass Courts will be used at Yeppoon Tennis Centre for 12/u & 10/u events. Yeppoon Courts are new and also has a clubhouse & great facilities.
9. **Exemptions:** Players must be available at all times during the tournament. No time exemptions will be granted.
10. **Entry Fees:** Singles \$50 Doubles \$20 each
11. **Balls:** Head Championship

12. TOURNAMENT RULES AND POLICIES

a) This tournament will be conducted in accordance with the Uniform Tennis Australia Anti-Corruption Program, Tennis Australia's Member Protection By-law, the applicable tournament rules and regulations and the Tennis Australia's Code of Behaviour (each as amended from time to time). "I acknowledge and agree that all Tennis Australia policies can be readily viewed at www.tennis.com.au and that it is my responsibility to view these and seek clarification, if required, from the Tennis Australia Tournaments & Competitions Department.

b) Acknowledgment of Policies, Rules and Regulations: As a participant in a Tennis Australia sanctioned event I agree to comply with and be bound by the ITF Rules of Play, the Uniform Tennis Anti-Corruption Program, the Tennis Australia Code of Behaviour (including its reference to spectator behaviour and interference), the Tennis Australia Member Protection By-Law and the Tennis Australia Anti-Doping Policy."

c) 'Uniform Tennis Anti-Corruption Program' statement: For players and their "related persons" (defined as 'any coach, trainer, therapist, physician, management representative, agent, family member, tournament guest, business associate or other affiliate or associate of any Player, or any other person who receives accreditation at an Event at the request of the Player or any other Related Person') – I acknowledge that Professional Tennis has a Uniform Tennis Anti-Corruption Program and the Program rules are included in the 2010 Official Grand Slam Rule Book. I accept that I must comply with and be bound by all provisions included in the Uniform Tennis Anti-Corruption Program. The Uniform Tennis Anti-Corruption Program prohibits certain conduct by a player and their "related persons", as defined in the rule, including, but not limited to, (i) wagering on any tennis match, (ii) contriving or attempting to contrive the outcome of any tennis match, (iii) providing for consideration information concerning the condition or status of players, and (iv) the failure to report to the Tennis Integrity Unit as soon as possible any knowledge I may have regarding potential violations of the Uniform Tennis Anti-Corruption Program. Nothing in this paragraph shall modify or limit the full text of the Uniform Tennis Anti-Corruption Program.

d) Spectator Behaviour Statement: Inappropriate spectator behaviour could result in denial of entry at future Tennis Australia and Member Association sanctioned events, and will be dealt with in accordance with the above policies. This includes, but is not limited to, behaviour at tennis venues, hotels and transport vehicles.

e) Publicity and Promotion: In consideration of accepting my entry into the tournament, I grant and assign to Tennis Australia and the host club/centre/association and any third party at the reasonable discretion of Tennis Australia the right in perpetuity throughout the world to make, use, show and reproduce at their discretion, motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television, sound recordings and any other reproductions of any description of me taken or produced during or in connection with the tournament. I agree that my name, voice, likeness, image and biographical material may also be used and reproduced in any way for the purpose of providing information and news in relation to the tournament, audio visual coverage, distribution and broadcast of the tournament, archival purposes, and publicising, promoting and advertising Tennis Australia and the tournament. I acknowledge and agree that this usage, including for commercial purposes, is without compensation or notice to myself, heirs, devisees, executors, administrators or assigns

f) Membership Number: It is mandatory that every entrant has a membership number, available by becoming a member of an affiliated tennis club or registering directly with their respective member (state) association. This shall not apply to events which carry ATP/WTA/ITF world ranking points.

g) Coach Statement: As an entrant in this event, Tennis Australia recommends that your coach is a TA certified coach. This will ensure that the coach:

- (i) Has a coaching qualification recognised by Tennis Australia and the Australian Sports Commission
- (ii) Has currently updated his/her coaching credentials via ongoing professional development
- (iii) Has met legislative requirements for Working With Children Check (or relevant State equivalent)
- (iv) Has an updated first aid qualification
